


HOW TO APPLY

On-line applications are welcome around the year. Unless special agreement conditions apply (of which potential candidates will be advised by their institutional contact person), the standard application materials package should include*:

- a completed and submitted On-line Application Form with the items below as uploads
- evidence of English language proficiency if the candidate`s first language is not English, and (s)he does not qualify for exemption from the requirement for English language testing
- · a Letter of Recommendation
- · a Statement of Purpose
- a Resume
- an official or certified transcript copy of all completed semesters from the higher education institution last or currently attended (If the official language of the document is other than English, a certified English-language translation is required instead.)
- if applicable, an official or certified copy of diploma from the higher education institution last attended (If the official language of the document is other than English, a certified Englishlanguage translation is required instead.)
- if applicable, a Certificate of Enrollment in English from the higher education institution currently attended
- if applicable, a Letter of Institutional Consent in English from the higher education institution currently attended.
